Drive Up Florida Blue Immunization Sites

- FL Blue Drive Up Clinic Hours: 10:00am- 1:00pm.
- Vaccinations offered include: flu, Hepatitis A and B, Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis "whooping cough"), MMR (measles, mumps and rubella), pneumonia and shingles.

- Most Florida Blue health plans cover vaccinations for their members (flu is typically \$0.00 co-pay)
- The FL Blue Immunization clinics are also open to all (out-of-pocket costs may differ between insurance companies and individual plans)

Off-site Vaccination Clinic scheduling process

What is needed for an easy transaction:

- Date/time requested(each)
- Legal Business Name-
- Address-
- Contact person name/title/phone# and email address for person responsible for the agreement.
- Contact person for day of each location- name/title/phone# and email address-
- Approximate number of employees (each)-
- Approximate number of Flu Vaccines to be administered at each site-
- Would you be needing Regular Flu and High Dose? (high dose is recommended for 65 and over)
- Will you want us to offer other vaccines as well? Pneumonia, Shingrix, Tdap, HepA, MMR?
- If so I would need approximate numbers for each as well.
- Does everyone have insurance? If not will you be paying for uninsured employees?
- If so-who will be the responsible party? Name/phone#/address and email.

Our minimum requirement is 25 shots per 2 hour time limit or 50 shots per 4 hour time limit.

A link will be provided for your employees to schedule their time to assist with Covid-19 guidelines in social distancing.



Preparing for your On-Site Immunization:

What is Walgreens Doing to Keep you Safe:

- We have daily screening for our employees, which includes a temperature check at the start of the day
- Our pharmacist follow standard OSHA safety protocols to prevent infection including handwashing or hand-sanitizing, changing gloves between immunizations, and swabbing the injection site with alcohol.
- In addition, our pharmacist wear surgical grade face masks, as well as face shields, to protect both patient and pharmacist.

We will send you Employer guidelines:

- Pre-Immunization Clinic Paperwork : VAR, (vaccine administration record) and VIS, (vaccine information statement)
- Guidelines on completing the VAR ahead of time.
- Ensure the space for immunizing is well-ventilated, clean with ample space for 6 feet social-distancing
- Non-fabric chairs (if possible) for disinfecting.
- Social Distancing Signage (for printing)
- Immunization Appointment scheduler link to ensure proper social distancing guidelines are followed.

Employees: Must wear a face mask or face covering.



Covid 19 Vaccines Coming Soon

CDC is partnering with CVS and **Walgreens** to offer on-site COVID-19 vaccination services for residents (and staff) of nursing homes and assisted living facilities. (Once vaccine is available)

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is reaching out to partners in preparation for various COVID-19 vaccination scenarios.

One scenario includes availability of vaccine in 2020 for prioritized patient populations, including long-term care facility staff and residents. This communication is intended to assist long-term care facilities, including assisted living and similar congregate living facilities serving adults 65 years of age and up, in planning for vaccination of their residents.

Please follow these instructions and/or share if any senior facilities requests the information or has questions.

Skilled nursing facilities (SNFs) will make their selection through the [National Healthcare Safety Network](#) (NHSN). An "alert" will be incorporated into the NHSN LTCF COVID-19 module to guide users to the form.
